# Electrolytic Removal Of Rust On Ferrous Metals

### WARNING

This setup must be in a well ventilated area as the gases released are hydrogen & oxygen which are highly volatile. No naked flames.

Before you begin using your setup, remove any rust from your sacrificial anode with a grinder as it speeds up the process if you start with clean steel.

You should not have too much trouble buying an old style battery charger in second-hand shops or at garage sales.

### ITEMS REQUIRED

- Old type battery charger, with a 6 amp charging rate or better.
- Sacrificial anode. A piece of 1.5"x.125"x18" flat steel bar can be used.
- Lectric Brand Washing Soda\*. (Or other brand)
- A large heavy duty plastic barrel. It must be a non-metal type.

## **METHOD**

- Measure a quantity of ordinary tap water into your container. (Litres or Gallons 1 litre= 1 kg. 1 gall = 10 lbs.).
- Add 10% by weight of washing soda to water & stir solution till dissolved.
- Attach a piece of mild steel wire to item to be cleaned & submerge it the solution. It is not necessary to remove paint from the object being cleaned as the process does this in most cases.
- Connect the negative terminal of the battery charger to the wire.
- Connect positive terminal to sacrificial anode. Do not allow sacrificial anode to come in contact with item being cleaned otherwise battery charger will be destroyed.
- Turn battery charger on & adjust amperage by lifting the anode up or down in the solution to keep the current at least 1 amp below maximum battery charger rate.
- Once charging rate drops to approximately 1 amp, remove item

being cleaned & wash with a high pressure hose. This may take anywhere between an hour and up to 24 hours, depending on size of article and condition.

- Scrub item with a wire brush or stainless steel scourer to remove any loose material. Do not use steel wool.
- Remove sacrificial anode & remove rust debris & wire brush till clean and return to the solution.
- If the item requires further rust removal, place back in solution and repeat process.
- Once clean, dry the item. You may want to use a heat gun to ensure it is completely dry.
- To stop the item rusting, it can be coated with a 10% solution of linseed oil in mineral turps or painted immediately.
- Top up water level when required. No extra washing soda is required.

# PLEASE NOTE. Do not reverse the polarity of the battery charger; otherwise your item being cleaned will become your sacrificial anode!

The anode will require replacement from time to time as it is eroded away by the process.

\* Lectric Brand Washing Soda is available from Coles & Woolworths in 1kg packs.

## **NHMA** Insurance

From the NHMA June 2015 Newsletter.

The NHMA Committee are pleased to advise that the following amendments to the cover offered through the Personal Accident policy have been arranged:

- The upper age limit has been extended to cover persons up to 90 years; however a sliding scale applies to some benefits.
- The loss of earnings benefit has been raised from \$500 per week to \$750 per week.
- Member clubs with 50 or less members can now nominate up to 3 non-member community volunteers who assist with the setting up and packing up at events run by the club. There is a limit of 100 such community volunteers Australia wide names, arrangements etc are to be made with the NHMA secretary at least 14 days prior to the event.
