LIFE OF A MF 135 – PART 1



On the 17th of October 1974 a brand new MF 135, 3 cylinder diesel, 8 speed tractor was delivered to our family farm at Table Cape. It was purchased to replace a Ferguson 4 cylinder FE 35 diesel and work alongside our 1967 3 cylinder, 6 speed diesel MF 135. Over the next 20 years they worked tirelessly on a variety of farming tasks on our very steep 50 hectare farm bordering Fossil Bluff. The MF 135 was well suited to this terrain and proved to be an invaluable addition to the dairying property.

In the spring they were both used for ploughing, discing, cultivating and harrowing before drilling or spinning on fertiliser, grass seed, oats and chou moullier. Also at this time of year an MF 80 fully mounted forage harvester was attached to the 135 to make silage for autumn and winter feed. Following silage making the 135's were used for mowing, raking, baling and carting hay.

Other attachments included a grader blade to keep all the gravel roads and table drains up to scratch, a post-hole digger for fencing upgrades, a rear end loader and tip-trailer for numerous jobs around the farm, a carry-all and an MF jib crane for all the heavy lifting.

In September 1990 whilst feeding out hay on the rugged sea frontage, my late father accidently left the hand brake off on the 1974 135 or didn't engage it properly, and it made a rapid descent towards the ocean with our nine year old son jumping off the carryall just in time. Several cartwheels later, some horrified gasps and head shaking from above, it came to rest upside down against a Blackwood tree growing in amongst a stand of tea trees that bordered the cliff face. This lone sturdy tree saved the poor girl from a terrifying 30 metre drop into the abyss below. As fate would have it she was rescued with the aid of a MF 135 and a Ferguson winch! After a month of both major and minor repairs and some well earned TLC it was back to work for the old girl and she barely

Then in 1994, the farm was sold and everything else with it at our farm clearing sale, apart from the 1974 MF 135 and a few attachments. I restored the older model 135 prior to the sale along with other farm equipment.

We moved to Leith and for the next 17 years the tractor was used in a variety of new ways. It was the best vehicle for launching our boat off the sandy beach and into the Forth

River, and this was a regular occurrence with our three eager young fishermen on board. As we lived at the end of a no through road we had numerous requests to help unwitting drivers pull their bogged cars out of the beach shingles, the 135 made easy work of it! During the spring/summer months I used the tractor and a Howard slasher to cut grass blocks and paddocks around the local area building up a loyal clientele over many years. The tractor also came in handy when clearing parts of our double block that had become overgrown, pulling out undergrowth and stumps etc, and the rear end loader was the ideal tool for stoking our twice yearly backyard garden heap burn-offs.

In 1999 and 2000 I secured a contract to use my tractor at Parramatta Creek Orchard to cart bins of apples from the rows to a pickup area. In order to carry out this work the MF 135 had to be modified for the orchard. This required narrow back wheels, removing the roll bar, fitting a down swept exhaust, a low air breather and attaching a set of forks.

In late 2009 I became ill with a hip infection and I was forced into an early retirement due to complications. We also had to sell up at
