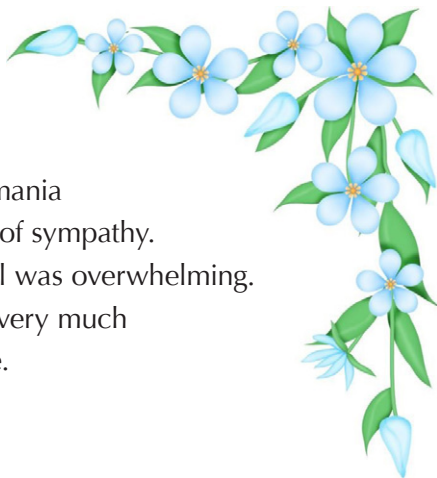

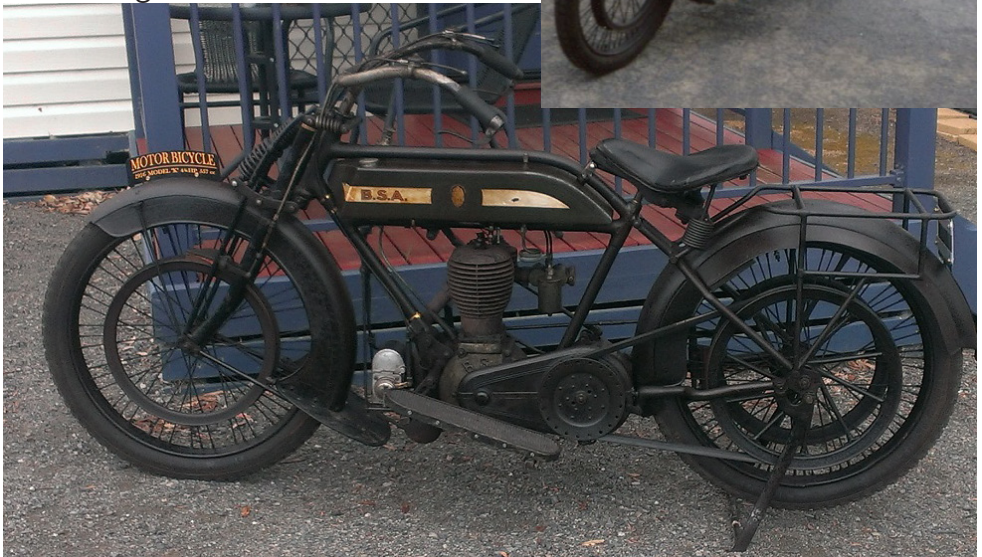
Restoration of a 1916 Model K BSA

I have had the good fortune to be able to buy this Model K BSA. I have replaced the wire in the original control cables (using the original nipples and ends) but with new wires and the original levers, replaced the Frame neck bearings, repacked the front and rear wheel bearings, cleaned the oil pump plunger, flushed the fuel system, was able to free up the tank drain and prime tap and delivery spout.

Put some new rubber on the foot boards, new tyres and tubes and a new rear drive belt. Had the Original Brook Leather Saddle covered with its water marks and name badge, repaired the stitching.

The old machine had not been used since the early 1920s and after learning about the spark, throttle, air lever and the mixture adjustment it started after laying up for more than 93 years. It was a big thrill when it sprang into life after only a few kicks. I have now got the Bike on Club Rego and enjoy riding the Machine on every chance I get.

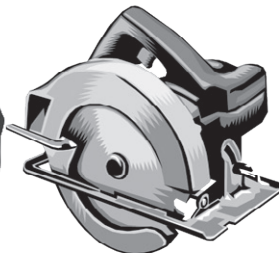
